### **DIVISION 5—ARTS & CRAFTS, PHOTOGRAPHY & PAINTINGS**

**CRAFT** CLASSES 61–68 (inclusive): **All entries to be made by yourself and NOT TO HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY SHOWN**

61. TIME TO RE-CYCLE – make something from predominantly recycled materials [e.g. wood, metal, plastic, fabric remnants, left over wool etc.]
62. AN ADVENT CALENDAR Any craft.
63. A TEA COSY – make the latest fashion accessory for your tea pot! – Any soft craft.
64. A SHOPPING BAG – don't pay for the plastic ones. – Any soft craft.
65. A BROOCH OR CORSAGE – any craft, wood, metal work, fabric, crochet etc.  
Dictionary definition of a corsage – a small spray of flowers, worn pinned at the shoulder, waist or wrist.
66. AN ITEM FOR A CHILD – any craft. Could be a gift, toy, item of clothing.
67. ANY OTHER SOFT CRAFT - e.g. hand/machine embroidery, knitting, soft toy, etc.
68. ANY OTHER HARD CRAFT – e.g. pottery, woodwork, metal work, etc.

**PHOTOGRAPHY** CLASSES 69–74 (inclusive) **Photographs must be taken by entrant, and not previously displayed at this show. Cameras and camera phones may be used in all classes except for class 69, which is for camera phones only. The Society will not accept responsibility in the case of dispute over ownership. Photos to be mounted on card — finished display not larger than A4.**

**Photos MUST be handed to Show Steward for display—THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL**

69. PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN ON A CAMERA PHONE. (i.e. mobile, tablet, i-pad etc. but not camera.
70. RUINS – any ruins, from castle to shed!
71. FARM ANIMAL/S.
72. A LEAF OR LEAVES.
73. YOUR FAVOURITE PHOTO.
74. PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN IN THE HILLTOP VILLAGES.

**ART:** CLASSES 75-78 Original painting/picture, designed and executed by you. Please present pictures with facility to hang for display

75. A PAINTING in Oils or Acrylic
76. A PICTURE in any other medium (excluding photography or craft)
77. VEGETABLE/S - in any medium excluding photography or craft.
78. A PICTURE IN MINIATURE any medium excl. photography or craft, no more than 6x4 ins. or 10x15 cms.
