DIVISION 5—ART, CRAFT & PHOTOGRAPHY

Open to all ages

CRAFT: CLASSES 62–67 (inclusive). *All entries to be made by yourself and NOT TO HAVE BEEN PREVIOUSLY SHOWN IN THIS SHOW*

62. PAPER-CRAFT an item made from or decorated with paper. e. g. quilling, decoupage, paper sculpture, a mask, mobile, Christmas decoration or greetings card etc.
63. A USEFUL ITEM FOR THE HOME e.g. Cushion, lampshade, cover for a tissue box, tea cosy, chair, basket, door stop etc. any craft.
64. A DECORATIVE WREATH (max diameter 30cms /12ins.) or GARLAND or BUNTING made from anything *except fresh plant material*.
65. ANY ITEM ON A GARDEN THEME (hard or soft craft) could be fabric, wood, metal OR, a picture (not a stand-alone painting or photograph but could include elements of these), OR, any item decorated with a pattern based on an aspect of the garden. These can be stitched, knitted, embroidered or embellished. Could also be a scarecrow, willow plant support etc. These are just a few suggestions. You may enter two items in class 65.
66. A CLOTHING ACCESSORY – e. g. hat, scarf, brooch etc. any craft.
67. ANY CRAFT ITEM CREATED DURING THE PANDEMIC. May enter two items in class 67.

PHOTOGRAPHY: CLASSES 69–74 (inclusive). *Photographs must be taken by the entrant, and not previously displayed at this show. The Society will not accept responsibility in the case of dispute over ownership. Photos to be mounted on card — finished display no larger than A4.*

Photos MUST be handed to Show Steward for display—THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL

69. PHOTOGRAPH OF ANY GARDEN YOU HAVE VISITED You may enter 2 images
70. PHOTOGRAPH OF AN EXPANSE OF FLOWERS. e .g. a garden or wild flower meadow.
71. PHOTOGRAPH OF 'THE WEATHER'.
72. PHOTOGRAPH OF A GARDEN BUILDING e.g. shed, greenhouse, folly etc.
73. YOUR FAVOURITE PHOTO(S). Two photographs may be entered.
74. ANY PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN DURING THE PANDEMIC. Two photographs may be entered.

ART: CLASSES 75-78 (inclusive). *Original painting/picture, designed and executed by the entrant. Please state the medium used for exhibit on entry card and present pictures with facility to hang for display. All classes exclude photography and craft.*

75. A PAINTING in Oils or Acrylic
76. A PICTURE in any medium.
77. A PICTURE OF A GARDEN in any medium
78. ANY PICTURE, ANY SUBJECT, ANY MEDIUM NOT PHOTOGRAPHY, CREATED DURING THE PANDEMIC (May enter 2)
